TOURNAMENT	<p>Schools enter any number of teams of four only. Children may also compete in teams of two or three or as individuals if schools are unable to make up a team of four. All children play six/seven rounds with 30 mins maximum per game. Open and Intermediate divisions will use competition analogue/digital clocks, and will compete in one pool, while Novice and Beginner will compete in a second pool.</p> <p>The children will compete in four divisions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) Open – teams with an average Qld Junior Chess Rating greater than 600(b) Intermediate – teams with an average Qld Junior Chess Rating less than 600(c) Novice – teams with unrated players or one or two rated players who have previously competed in interschool competitions.(d) Beginner – teams with a majority of unrated players and/or competing in their first year of interschool competition <p>Swiss style tournament enables children of all levels to participate. Winners play winners etc, so by round three, children play an opponent of a similar standard. 1 point for a win, 0.5 point for a draw, 0 point for a loss.</p>
PRIZES	Trophy for winning team in each division, individual trophies for members of winning teams, medallions for place getters.
LUNCH	A Tuckshop will be operating on that day. If children wish to purchase food, they will need to order before 9:00. Simply write your name and order on an envelope with money enclosed. The convener will be seeking the assistance of some generous parents. It is a good idea for children to bring enough water for the day as there are no bubblers at the venue. Water will be on sale.
VENUE	Fernvale Community Hall, Banks Creek Road Fernvale. It is a good idea for children to bring an activity i.e., tennis ball, book, cards, etc to keep them busy between rounds.
ENTRY FEE	\$5.00 per competitor. Each School is responsible for money collection, and will be invoiced after the event . Do not bring any payment on the day. Each school group must be supervised by a teacher/ responsible adult.
