### Giant outdoor chess pieces

The King is 640mm high with a 240mm base.



The pieces are black and white and are made from moulded PVC, with detachable bases allowing the pieces to be weighted with sand, water or similar if desired. A board is not included but floor tiles or pavers may be used to form the board of 64 squares, each square approx 350mm x 350mm.

**The special school price is \$965 (inc GST) plus delivery of \$100**

### Outdoor terrace chess pieces

The King is 310mm high with a 100mm base.

Colours are black and white and made from moulded PVC. A chessboard is not included but floor tiles etc may be used to form the board of 64 squares, each square approx 150mm x 150mm. Otherwise, a mat or tiles can be purchased.
